

Haarstick Sailmakers Sail Inspection

Before we go over the following check list, every sail is hung up on our Inspection Rig as apposed to laying it out on the floor. This allows us to get under the sail and see every seam and panel with back lighting. It also lets us check all the edges at eye level.

Mainsails and Mizzen:

- ✓ Inspect Luff Slides and Shackles
- ✓ Inspect for Worn Webbing at Corners of Sail
- ✓ Inspect Seams, Tapes and Bolt Rope for Broken Stitching
- ✓ Inspect Batten Pockets for Holes and Leech End Seizing
- ✓ Inspect Leech Line, Exits and Cleats
- ✓ Install New Telltales

Headsails and Staysails:

- ✓ Inspect Luff Hanks and Grommets
- ✓ Inspect Luff foil for Tears and Sear at Head
- ✓ Inspect Seams Tapes and Luff Boltrope or Foil for Broken Stitching
- ✓ Inspect Leech Line, Cleats and Covers
- ✓ Install New Telltales

Spinnakers:

- ✓ Inspect Sail for “Pinholes” and Patch w/ Sticky Dots
- ✓ Inspect Sail for larger holes
- ✓ Check for Broken Stitches
- ✓ Flake Sail
